



Standardized Tobacco E-Training for Los Angeles Responsible Retailers

ABOUT THE COURSE:

STELARR is a free online course for people who sell tobacco products and need to know what they must do to follow tobacco sales laws in the City of Los Angeles. The course shows how you can support our Los Angeles community by not selling tobacco to youth and by ending the sale of flavored tobacco products. It is currently available in three languages: English, Spanish and Armenian.

WHO CAN TAKE THE COURSE:

Some tobacco retailers are required to complete the STELARR course per an agreement with the City Attorney's Office or as part of a court case. However, anyone who sells tobacco products in the city of Los Angeles and members of the general public will benefit from taking the course and are welcome to do so. Everyone who completes the course and passes the quizzes will earn a certificate of completion.

By taking the course, you will be able to make positive changes in the Los Angeles community and support efforts to keep young people healthy and safe from the harms of tobacco use and vaping.

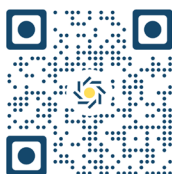
HOW TO BEGIN:

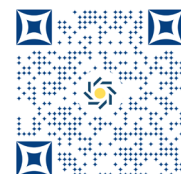
